

## Non-Immigrant (OA) Long Stay Visa

Applicants aged 50 years and over who wish to stay in Thailand for a period of not exceeding 1 year without the intention of working	1 year

※Visa fees must be paid by e-payment of the e-Visa system using a credit card (Visa or Master Card) only. The visa application fee is non-refundable.		

Required documents	
The following documents must be uploaded in large and clear JPEG and PDF formats (the file size must not exceed 3MB)	
1.	Biodata page of Passport or Travel Document
2.	Photograph taken within the last three months
3.	Proof of the <b>permanent residence</b> in the country where the application is submitted : - Please submit a family registration (戸籍謄本) issued within 3 months for Japanese nationality. - Please submit a certificate of residence (住民票) issued within 3 months or a copy of the residence card for non-Japanese nationality.
4.	Financial evidence: A bank statement showing a balance of at least 800,000 THB for the past three months, or an income certificate indicating a monthly income of at least 65,000 THB.
5.	Medical certificates showing no prohibitive diseases as indicated in the Ministerial Regulation No.14 (B.E. 2535) certificate shall be valid for not more than three months.
6.	Foreign Insurance Certificate as stipulated by the Office of Insurance Commission and Health Insurance of Thailand, which must be completed, signed, and stamped by the insurance company. The form can be downloaded from <a href="https://longstay.tgia.org">https://longstay.tgia.org</a>
7.	Health insurance issued by a Thai or foreign insurer for general illnesses, including COVID-19, with the insured sum of no less than 100,000 USD or 3,000,000 THB
8.	Certificate of criminal record clearance from the country of nationality or the country where the application is submitted. (Issue within 3 months).
